## Club Events

- <u>College ID Day</u> wide variation of opportunities. From driving College Coaches, to setup, to lunch, to snacks a variation of opportunity. Around 2-6 hours
- Northwest Cup
  - Part of Committee to run the event. At least Six Hours
  - Parking Attendants. Three Hours Shifts
  - Traffic Attendants. Three Hour Shifts
  - Parking Set up. 3-6 hours
  - · Tournament Set up. 6 Hours
  - · Garbage Litter Pick up. 3 hour Shift

#### Grass

- Litter and Garbage Detail. Pickup up Litter and Garbage and also dumping garbage cans into large garbage container. At least one hour per increments

### Parking Lot

- Grading of parking lot. At least Six Hours
- Parking Set up. Initial Setup and Helping Maintain Parking Set up. At least two hours per time.

### Facility Cleaning and Checking Equipment

- Goal Checking checking of all goals posts to ensure nets are properly up, all bolts and screws properly inputted and correct weights. At least two hours per time.
- Clubhouse Cleaning cleaning of the club house. One hour
- Weed Whacking different areas of the Polo Fields where weeds will need to be cut down. At least a two hour increment.
- Light set up Late Fall cranking up and turning on portable lights and bringing them down at the end of the night. At least Six Hours

#### Setup and Takedown
